

Hunting season is upon us!

Due to extremely dry conditions throughout the province, fire risk increases.

Hunters are reminded to take extra precautions during hunting season:

- Carry a fire extinguisher in your vehicle.
- Talk to landowners before going on their land.
- Avoid unnecessary vehicle idling.
- Walk whenever possible.
- Stay on existing trails.

Approximately 50 per cent of all wildfires are caused by people.

- Keep your vehicle out of tall grass stick to roads and trails.
 Mufflers and other parts can get hot enough to start a fire.
- When setting up your camp, pick an area free of tall grass.
- Seek landowner permission before accessing private lands, whether they are posted or not.
- Be prepared, carry a fire extinguisher, shovel, or other tools.
